CONCLUSIONS

- Regional cooperation and creation of efficient regional mechanisms for information exchange and regional analysis should be encouraged;
- High quality analysis are basis for well- defined policies;
- Interpretation capacities should be upgraded in order to improve filtering and registration of migrants;
- Recognized need for harmonization of the registration procedures in order to enable exchange of biometric data in order to avoid multiplication of registration and regional data networking;
- Additional efforts of the regional structures should be invested in facilitating the process of harmonizing national legislation with the EU acquis;
- Need to have higher level of synergy among regional and international structures in organizing trainings and meetings;
- Recognized efforts of MARRI to enhance cooperation and coordination with DCAF and FRONTEX;
- MARRI RC is invited, in cooperation with DCAF, to provide feedback in regards to Border Centers application among beneficiaries.
