

PROJECT: “Support of cooperation among border police on airports in Southeast Europe” –BORDAIRPOL

“Support of cooperation among border police on airports in Southeast Europe” – BORDAIRPOL was commenced on 01 January 2013 and it will last for 3 years. The Project is a follow up of the MARRI Regional Projects “Establishment of network for co-operation between border police on international airport border crossing points in MARRI Member States” and “Joint comprehensive approach in building co-operation between MARRI and SEPCA Member States’ border police on international airport border crossing points” implemented in the period 2010 – 2012 which resulted with completion of the main Project outcomes - Establishment of Permanent Inter-Regional Working Group/Network for Cooperation (PIRWG) and information exchange consisted of commanders of the border police units on main International airports.

Overall objective of the Project was to assist SEE Countries’ border police on international airports in their efforts to counteract irregular migration and to fight against terrorism and crime ensuring high level of security on sustainable and permanent basis.

Beneficiaries of the Project are Border police on main International Airports from SEE Countries - Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Macedonia, Moldova, Montenegro, Romania and Serbia.

Project activities are grouped around 3 core components dedicated to project objectives and outcomes, notably:

- Protected web site specifically intended to the PIRWG / NC created
- Annual meetings of the PIRWG / NC
- Organization of joint trainings
