

Bratislav Gasic, Minister of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Serbia

Bratislav Gasic was born on June 30, 1967 to a working family from father Radoj and mother Mirjana.

Education:

He graduated from the Elementary School "Jovan Jovanovic Zmaj" in Krusevac.

He received his high school education at the "Bosa Cvetic" Educational Center and obtained a construction technician diploma. He earned the title of graduate economist at the Faculty of Economics of the University of Nis.



Professional experience:

- Since 1989, he has been engaged in private entrepreneurship, first as the owner of the private company "Santos", and later as a co-owner of the mixed Greek-Serbian company "Saco doo".
 - He lived and worked in Greece for many years and was co-owner of the famous Serbian brand "Grand Kafa".
 - He was a deputy on the list of the Serbian Progressive Party until August 2012.
 - From March 2013 to December 2013, President of the Management Board of JP "Srbijagas".
 - From June 2012 to April 2014, the Mayor of Krusevac.
 - From April 2014 to February 2016, Minister of Defense and Government of the Republic of Serbia.
 - From May 29, 2017 to October 26, 2022, Director of the Security and Information Agency of the Government of the Republic of Serbia.
- From October 26, 2022, appointed to the position of Minister of Internal Affairs of the Government of the Republic of Serbia.

Other:

Served military service in 1985-1986 - VES driver in the field of engineering in Bela Crkva and Backa Topola. Prominent sports worker. In the 1990s, a member of the Assembly and the Board of Directors of the Volleyball Federation of Yugoslavia. Several times to the Board of Directors of the Football Club "Napredak" Krusevac. He was the owner of the women's volleyball club "Kruševac Santos" First B League. He was the Director of the football school of FC "Napredak"y for four years.

Political involvement:

Until the founding of the Serbian Progressive Party, he was not politically engaged, nor was he a member of another political party.

He is one of the founders of the Serbian Progressive Party.

Since 2009, he is in the Presidency of the Serbian Progressive Party.

He was the President of the Municipal Committee of the Serbian Progressive Party in Krusevac and the President of the District Committee of the Serbian Progressive Party for the Rasin District.

He was elected as a Deputy of the National Assembly of the Republic of Serbia.

In the period from 2012 to 2016, one of the Vice-Presidents of the Serbian Progressive Party.

By appointing him to the position of Director of the Security and Information Agency on May 29, 2017, he froze his membership in all positions in the Serbian Progressive Party.

Awards:

In 1998, the city of Krusevac named him manager of the year in the city of Krusevac.

In December 2012, the Board of Directors of NALED awarded him a special recognition for the achieved reforms in the city administration and contribution to the improvement of the economic environment.
