Taulant Balla was born on August 12, 1977. From July 2023, he is the Minister of the Interior in the Albanian Government.

He completed his higher and postgraduate studies in the branch of Political Sciences at "Al.I.Cuza" University in Iasi, Romania and then completed the Doctoral School where he defended the Thesis on "Reform of the Decision-Making System in the European Union" with the Magna Cum Laude rating.
