He was Minister of Information in the Transitional Government of Serbia in 2000. He has been President of the Socialist Party of Serbia since 2006.

He was First Deputy Prime Minister – Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of the Interior from July 2008 to July 2012. He served as Prime Minister and Minister of the Interior from July 2012 to April 2014. From April 2014 to October 2020, he was First



Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs. From October 2020 to August 2022, he served as Speaker of the National Assembly of the Republic of Serbia.

From October 2022 to May 2024 he served as First Deputy Prime Minister responsible for foreign policy and security and Minister of Foreign Affairs.

He has decades of experience and results achieved in participation and leadership in various executive and legislative bodies in the Republic of Serbia. In 2015, he chaired the OSCE.

He received the award "The Best Man of Europe" in 2009, the Order of Friendship of the Russian Federation in 2018, and the "Captain Miša Anastasijević" Statuette recognition in 2018.

He was decorated with the Order of Republika Srpska on a sash in 2022, on the occasion of Republika Srpska Day.

He was given the "Key to the City" award with the "Honorary Citizen of the City of Banja Luka" Charter for the year 2024.

He held the positions of President of Basketball Club Partizan from Belgrade, Vice President of the Yugoslav Olympic Committee and President of the Sports Association of Serbia.
