

Programme of non-working days in North Macedonia for 2026

In accordance with the Law on Holidays of the Republic of North Macedonia (Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia No. 21/98 and 18/07), non-working days in 2026 are:

For all citizens of the Republic of North Macedonia

- January 1 (Thursday), New Year's Day,
- January 7 (Wednesday), Christmas, the first day of Christmas according to the Orthodox calendar,
- March 20 (Friday) Ramadan Eid, the first day of Ramadan Eid,
- April 13 (Monday), Easter, the second day of Easter according to the Orthodox calendar,
- May 1 (Friday), Labour Day,
- May 24 (Sunday) "St. Cyril and Methodius" Day of All-Slavic Educators, i.e. May 25 (Monday) is a non-working day
- August 2 (Sunday), Republic Day, i.e. August 3 (Monday) is a non-working day
- September 8 (Tuesday), Independence Day
- October 11 (Sunday), National Uprising Day, i.e. October 12 (Monday) is a non-working day
- October 23 (Friday), Day of the Macedonian Revolutionary Struggle,
- December 8 (Tuesday), "St. Clement of Ohrid".

For citizens of Orthodox faith

- January 6 (Tuesday), Christmas Eve, the day before Christmas,
- January 19 (Monday), Epiphany (Voditsi),
- April 10 (Friday), Good Friday, Friday before Easter,
- May 29 (Friday), All Souls' Day, Friday before All Souls' Day,
- August 28 (Friday), Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (Great Mother of God).

For citizens of Catholic faith

- April 6 (Monday), Easter, the second day of Easter,
- November 1 (Sunday), the Feast of All Saints,
- December 25 (Friday), the first day of Christmas.

For citizens of Muslim faith

- May 27 (Wednesday), Eid al-Adha, the first day of Eid al-Adha,

For citizens belonging to the Albanian community in the Republic of North Macedonia

- November 22 (Sunday), Albanian Alphabet Day.

For citizens belonging to the Serbian community in the Republic of North Macedonia

- January 27 (Tuesday), Saint Sava.

For citizens belonging to the Roma community in the Republic of North Macedonia

- April 8 (Wednesday), International Roma Day.

For citizens belonging to the Vlach community in the Republic of North Macedonia

- May 23 (Saturday), National Day of the Vlachs.

For citizens belonging to the Jewish community in the Republic of North Macedonia

- September 21 (Monday), Yom Kippur, the first day of Yom Kippur.

For citizens belonging to the Bosniak community in the Republic of North Macedonia

- September 28 (Monday), International Day of Bosniaks.

For citizens belonging to the Turkish community in the Republic of North Macedonia

- December 21 (Monday), Turkish Language Teaching Day.
